Advanced Paediatric Clinical Assessment

This course has been designed to give paediatric nurses and midwives a broader knowledge base in the areas that are unique to the growth and development, and health assessment of infants, children, and adolescents.

Objectives

- Obtain a comprehensive or symptom focused patient history from the parent, and evaluate the health of the family unit during the comprehensive history.
- Evaluate the developmental stage of the infant, child and adolescent.
- Identify normal findings and variations from normal in the physical examination of infants, children, and adolescents.

Content

- Paediatric Health History
- Paediatric Oral Health Assessment
- Paediatric Ear Assessment
- Paediatric Cardiac Assessment
- Newborn Assessment
- Paediatric Musculoskeletal Assessment
- Paediatric Neurological & Developmental Assessment

Methods

Lecture, classroom learning activities, skills training, web based learning, and selected course readings

Audience and Level

The target audiences are nurses, midwives, and other health professionals focused on the care of infants, children, and adolescents.

The Module is held at an advanced level. Participants are expected to have basic knowledge in anatomy and physiology.
